

The Gospel Preached to Abraham

Galatians 3:8

And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, *saying*, In thee shall all nations be blessed.

Romans 4:17-20

¹⁷ (As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, *even* God, who quickeneth the dead, and *calleth those things which be not as though they were*.

¹⁸ Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be. ¹⁹ And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sara's womb: ²⁰ He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God;

Hebrews 11:17-19

¹⁷ By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten *son*, ¹⁸ Of whom it was said, That in Isaac shall thy seed be called: ¹⁹ Accounting that God *was* able to raise *him* up, even from the dead; from whence also he received him in a figure.

Genesis 16:1

Now Sarai Abram's wife bare him no children: and she had an handmaid, an Egyptian, whose name *was* Hagar.

Genesis 17:16

And I will bless her, and give thee a son also of her: yea, I will bless her, and she shall be a *mother* of nations; kings of people shall be of her.

Genesis 18:9-15

⁹ And they said unto him, Where *is* Sarah thy wife? And he said, Behold, in the tent. ¹⁰ And he said, I will certainly return unto thee according to the time of life; and, lo, Sarah thy wife shall have a son. And Sarah heard *it* in the tent door, which *was* behind him. ¹¹ Now Abraham and Sarah *were* old *and* well stricken in age; *and* it ceased to be with Sarah after the manner of women. ¹² Therefore Sarah laughed within herself, saying, After I am waxed old shall I have pleasure, my lord being old also? ¹³ And the LORD said unto Abraham, Wherefore did Sarah laugh, saying, Shall I of a surety bear a child, which am old? ¹⁴ Is any thing too hard for the LORD? At the time appointed I will return unto thee, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son. ¹⁵ Then Sarah denied, saying, I laughed not; for she was afraid. And he said, Nay; but thou didst laugh.

John 8:56-59

⁵⁶ Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw *it*, and was glad. ⁵⁷ Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham? ⁵⁸ Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am. ⁵⁹ Then took they up stones to

cast at him: but Jesus hid himself, and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by.

Calling things that be not

Genesis 42:13

And they said, Thy servants *are* twelve brethren, the sons of one man in the land of Canaan; and, behold, the youngest *is* this day with our father, and one *is* not.

Proverbs 12:7

The wicked *are* overthrown, and *are* not: but the house of the righteous shall stand.

Jeremiah 10:20

My tabernacle is spoiled, and all my cords are broken: my children are gone forth of me, and they *are* not: *there is* none to stretch forth my tent any more, and to set up my curtains.

Job 7:8

The eye of him that hath seen me shall see me no *more*: thine eyes *are* upon me, and I *am* not.

Genesis 5:24

And Enoch walked with God: and he *was* not; for God took him.

Genesis 42:32

We *be* twelve brethren, sons of our father; one *is* not, and the youngest *is* this day with our father in the land of Canaan.

Jeremiah 31:15

Thus saith the LORD; A voice was heard in Ramah, lamentation, *and* bitter weeping; Rahel weeping for her children refused to be comforted for her children, because they *were* not.

Genesis 44:20

And we said unto my lord, We have a father, an old man, and a child of his old age, a little one; and his brother is dead, and he alone is left of his mother, and his father loveth him.

In Isaac seed called

Of whom it was said, That in Isaac shall thy seed be called:

Genesis 21:12

And God said unto Abraham, Let it not be grievous in thy sight because of the lad, and because of thy bondwoman; in all that Sarah hath said unto thee, hearken unto her voice; for in Isaac shall thy seed be called.

The seed which is Christ

Galatians 3:16

Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ.

Genesis 15:5

And he brought him forth abroad, and said, Look now toward heaven, and tell the stars, if thou be able to number them: and he said unto him, So shall thy seed be.

Righteous seed

Psalms 25:13

His soul shall dwell at ease; and his seed shall inherit the earth.

Psalms 37:25

I have been young, and *now* am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.

Psalms 69:36

The seed also of his servants shall inherit it: and they that love his name shall dwell therein.

Psalms 102:28

The children of thy servants shall continue, and their seed shall be established before thee.

Psalms 112:2

His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the upright shall be blessed.

Proverbs 11:21

Though hand *join* in hand, the wicked shall not be unpunished: but the seed of the righteous shall be delivered.

Proverbs 14:26

In the fear of the LORD *is* strong confidence: and his children shall have a place of refuge.

Proverbs 20:7

The just *man* walketh in his integrity: his children *are* blessed after him.

1 John 3:9

Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for *his seed remaineth* in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

Seed Spores

Matthew 13:36-41

³⁶ Then Jesus sent the multitude away, and went into the house: and his disciples came unto him, saying, Declare unto us the parable of the tares of the field. ³⁷ He answered and said unto them, He that soweth the good seed is the Son of man; ³⁸ The field is the world; the good seed are the children of the kingdom; but the tares are the children of the wicked *one*; ³⁹ The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels. ⁴⁰ As therefore the tares are gathered and burned in the fire; so shall it be in the end of this world. ⁴¹ The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity;

Luke 8:11

Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God.

Seed

4703

Greek Word: σπόρος

Transliteration: sporos

Root: from G4687

Part of Speech: n m

a *scattering* (of seed), i.e. (concrete) *seed* (as sown) :- seed (× sown).

4681

Greek Word: σπείρω

Transliteration: speirō

Root: probably strengthened from G4685 (through the idea of extending)

Part of Speech: v

to *scatter*, i.e. *sow* (literal or figurative) :- sow (-er), receive seed

4690

Greek Word: σπέρμα

Transliteration: sperma

Root: from G4687

Part of Speech: n n

something *sown*, i.e. *seed* (including the male “*sperm*”); by implication *offspring*; specially a *remnant* (figurative as if kept over for planting) :- issue, seed.
